

Know your rights



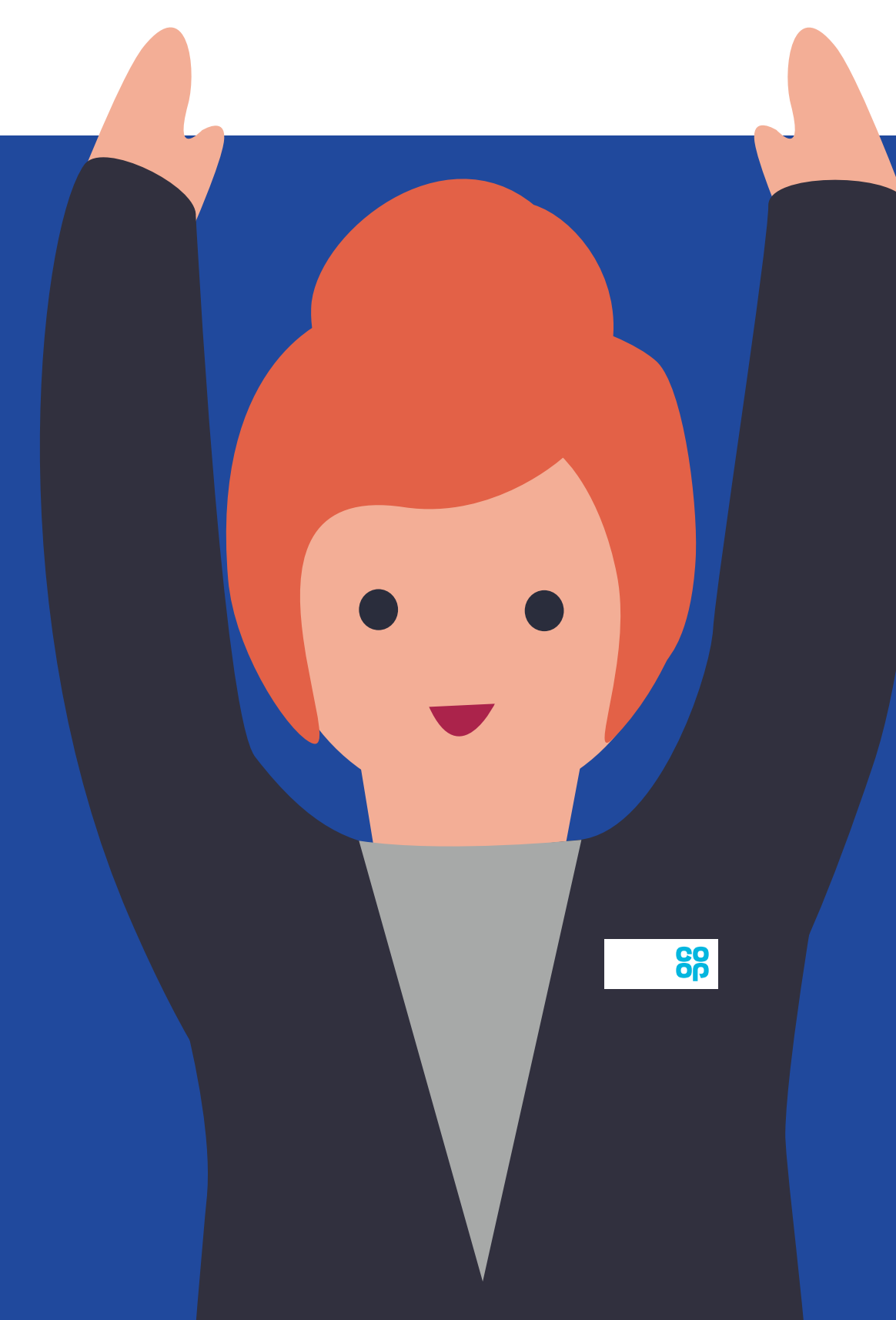
The right to be informed

You should know and understand what happens with your personal information.



The right to view your personal information

You can access your personal information free of charge.



The right to make changes to your personal information

You can ask to have your personal information changed or corrected if wrong.



The right to erasure

An organisation must delete your information if it doesn't have a good reason to keep it.

Know your rights



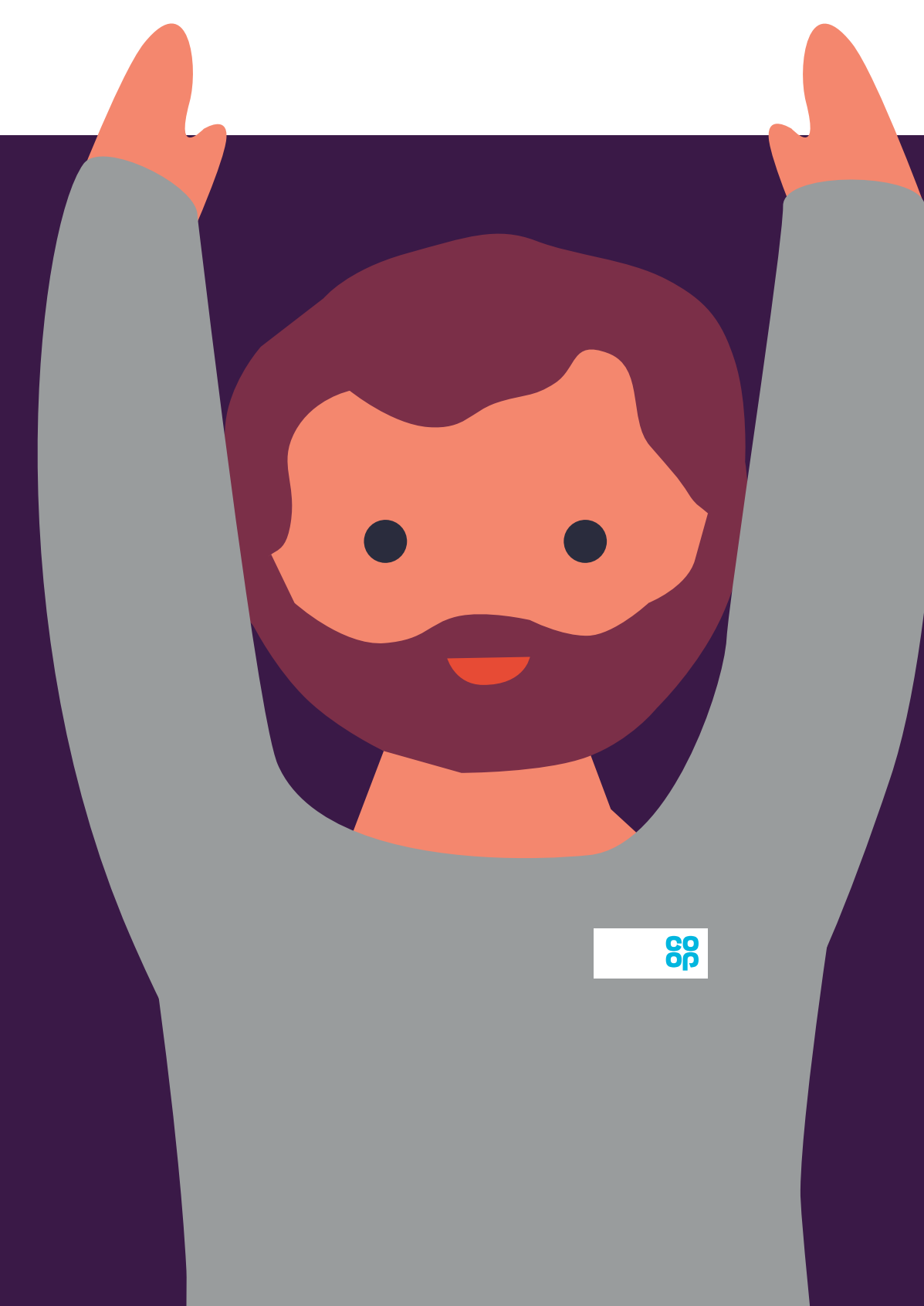
The right to limit how your personal information is used

You can block and put restrictions on how your personal information is used if it's inaccurate or unnecessary.



The right to move your personal information

You can obtain and reuse your personal information with other services and providers.



The right to say no

You can stop direct marketing and data processing when there's no 'compelling reason' to do it.



The right to challenge automatic decision-making

You can stop automated decisions being made about you if it has legal or significant consequences.
